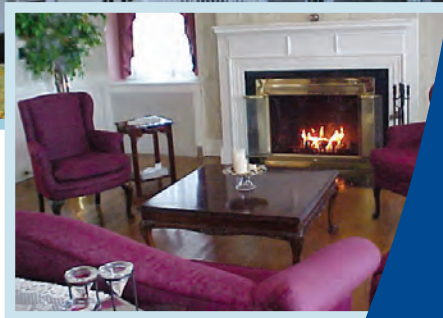
Built at the turn of the 20th century Valcour Educational Conference Center offers a peaceful and serene setting for your next social or professional event.

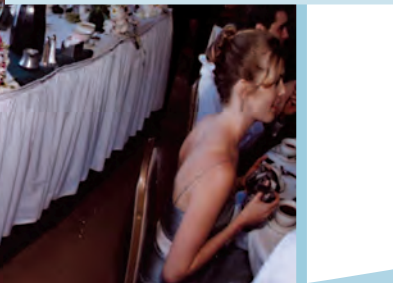

A HISTORICAL SETTING

In the narrow channel between Valcour Island and the shores of Lake Champlain where Valcour Educational Conference Center now stands, Benedict Arnold chose to anchor his fleet and await a large British force under Sir Guy Carleton. On the morning of October 11, 1776 the pivotal Battle of Valcour began.

Although the result of the engagement was disastrous, the Americans gained great credit for the obstinacy of their resistance. It certainly impeded the progress of the British fleet and played an important part in causing them to retire to winter quarters in Canada, allowing the Americans time to regroup, eventually defeating the British in the Battle of Saratoga.

How to Get There

FROM THE NORTH

- Take I-87 south to Exit 35
- Turn left onto 442 East/Bear Swamp Road
- Turn left onto Route 9 north

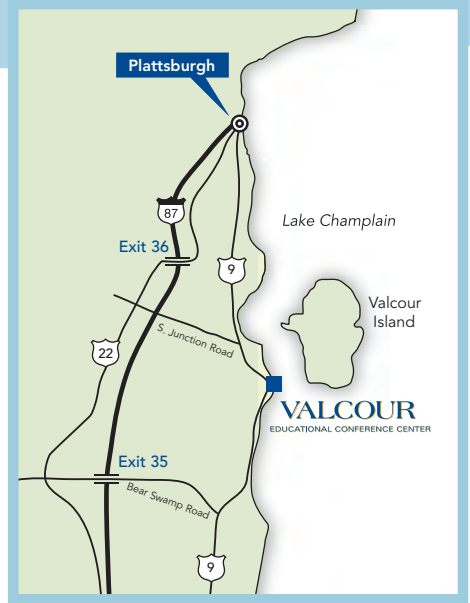
The Conference Center is approximately 2 miles on the right.

- Turn right onto Bear Swamp Road
- Turn left onto Route 9 north
