From Burlington, VT Airport

Burlington King Street/Port Kent Ferry (This scenic ferry ride is approximately 1 hour but is not open year round) Total mileage from Burlington Airport to King Street Ferry is approximately 3.5 miles

- Start out going south on Airport Drive toward long-term parking
- Turn right onto White Street
- Turn slight right onto Williston Road
- Continue and stay straight to go onto Main Street
- Turn left onto Battery Street
- Turn right onto King Street and you will see a toll booth for the ferry to New York
- When you get off the ferry in Port Kent, NY turn right onto Route 9 south.
- Travel approximately 12 miles and Valcour will be on your right

From Burlington, VT Airport

Grand Isle /Cumberland Head Ferry Open Year Round (approximately 20 minute ferry ride)

Total mileage from Burlington Airport to Grand Isle Ferry is approximately 23.5 miles)

- Start out going south on Airport Drive toward Elizabeth Street
- Turn right onto White Street
- Turn slight right onto Williston Road
- Merge onto I89 North, travel approximately 9 miles
- Take Exit 17 onto US-2W, travel approximately 10 miles
- Turn left onto VT-314, travel approximately 2.3 miles to the Grand Isle Ferry Dock
- When you get off the ferry travel straight onto Cumberland Head Road
- At the four corners traffic light, travel straight and take I87 South
- Take Exit 36
- Turn left onto Route 22
- Turn onto South Junction Road
- Take South Junction Road to Route 9
- Valcour is approximately 1.5 miles on the left

New York State Interstate 87

From the South:

- I87 Exit 35
- Right on Bear Swamp Road
- Bear Swamp Road to Route 9
- Left onto Route 9
- Valcour Inn and Boathouse is approximately 2 miles on the right

From the North:

- I87 to Exit 36
- Left onto Route 22
- Left onto South Junction Road
- South Junction Road to Route 9
- Valcour is approximately 1.5 miles on the left

From Malone (Route 11)

- Travel on Route 11 to the Village of Champlain
- At the light at the end of the village turn left onto Route 22,
- Proceed for approximately 20 miles
- Merge onto I87 South
- I87 to Exit 36
- Left onto Route 22
- Left onto South Junction Road
- South Junction Road to Route 9
- Valcour is approximately 1.5 miles on the left

From Points in Plattsburgh**From Plattsburgh City Proper:**

- From the downtown area travel straight on Broad Street
- Continue straight on Broad Street in the left lane
- At the third light (Broad Street ends) turn on to U.S. Avenue (which eventually turns into Route 9 South)
- Continue straight on this road for approximately 10 miles.
- Valcour is on your left, on the lakeside – a sign marks the driveway on the same side of the street.

From Route 3/Cornelia Street Area**Take I87 South:**

- I87 to Exit 35
- Turn left onto 442 East/Bear Swamp Road
- Go to the end of 442 East/Bear Swamp Road
- Turn left onto Route 9 North
- Valcour Inn and Boathouse is approximately 2 miles on the right
- The Inn is the large building overlooking the lake with the red door and carport

From SUNY Plattsburgh Campus:

- Travel down Rugar Street toward the downtown area to the light
- Bear to your right, continue straight on Broad Street in the left lane
- At the third light (Broad Street ends) turn right onto U.S. Avenue (which eventually turns into Route 9 South)
- Continue straight on this road for approximately 10 miles. (A few landmarks on Route 9 South include; the old Plattsburgh Air Force Base, Clare and Carl's Michigan Stand, Bluff Point Golf Club and Resort and a metal sculpture garden on your right by a retired high school teacher and his students.)
- Valcour is on your left, on the lakeside – a sign marks the driveway on the same side of the street.
